The position will be based on a permanent civil law employment contract with the university in accordance with § 98, UG 2002 [University Act].

RESPONSIBILITIES

This professorship is intended to continue and expand research and teaching in the field of sport economics, while also defining own focus areas; an integration of the topics sports tourism, sports management and sports sociology is desirable.

Close cooperation with the institute's chairs of performance physiology, sport and exercise psychology, neurophysiology and biomechanics, as well as with the Faculty of Economics and Statistics and the Faculty of Business and Management is expected. Participation in the research centers Alpine Sport, Tourism and Leisure, as well as in the planned research center Prevention and Health over the Lifespan is desired.

The teaching responsibilities include the supervision of sport-economic, sport-tourism, sport-management and sport sociology-related courses in the teaching programs of sports management, physical education, and sports science. Supervision of master / diploma theses and dissertations is expected.

Transfer of knowledge into society through appropriate publications, lectures, and further education is an additional goal.

- (a) a pertinent degree in higher education in Austria or the equivalent abroad with a focus on sports economics;
- b) venia legendi or equivalent teaching qualification;
- c) publications in international peer-reviewed journals;
- d) involvement in international research;
- e) relevant international experience;

- g) experience in attracting research funding;
- h) leadership and management skills.
